Parliamentary law is the area of legal rules under which deliberative bodies (Sejm and Senat) conduct their proceedings. Polish parliamentary law is statutory, rather than conventional, thus most legal mechanisms on this field are based on two fundamental deeds: the Constitution Republic of Poland and the Statute of Parliament (Regulamin Sejmu).

The lecture involves issues of high importance like:

- a) the legal position of polish parliament in the sphere of constitutional organs structure,
- b) the legal relations with the executive organs (government and president), including constitutional functions, exercising by the legislative authority,
- c) the constitutional status of deputies in Poland,
- d) the inner structure of both assemblies and its functioning in polish political system.
